

HILL GROUP HISTORY

The first meeting of The Hill Group of Alcoholics Anonymous took place on September 30th, 1984 at the Pelham Arena on Haist Road, Fonthill at 9.00pm. The founding member was Russ H. who founded the group upon persistent requests from Rufus F-A of Port Colborne. In December 1984 the group relocated to Concordia Lutheran Church, corner of South Pelham Road and Welland Road, Fonthill. In 1987 it moved to its current location at Holy Trinity Church, Pelham Road, Fonthill and at some point the time changed to 8.00pm. The original format was an open speaker meeting, however that changed in January 2012 to an Open Big Book Discussion Group. The Hill Group has, over the years, been a very active service orientated group placing members at Intergroup, GSO and various Region events.
