

NIAGARA DISTRICT INTERGROUP WEBSITE GUIDELINES WHEN REQUESTING NEW POSTINGS AND/OR CHANGES TO EXISTING INFORMATION

1. Information to be posted must observe and be in alignment with all of the Twelve Traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous.

2. All relevant information must be supplied ie. Group/Meeting name, complete address, meeting day & time. meeting format, wheelchair accessible. contact name, tel number & email address----a form has been developed and is available on the Niagara District Intergroup Website which can be used as a guideline

3. Information that is being requested to be posted on our Website must be emailed directly to **info@aaniagara.org** for record keeping purposes. Presenting your Group's or Meeting's intentions at District or Intergroup Business Meetings can be beneficial.

4. Niagara District Intergroup Website supplies **basic** information only. We do not promote or endorse any Groups or Meetings Listed on the Website. (eg. "our group gives away free hotdogs".)

5. Any change to an already existing posting needs to supply all pertinent information ie. Group/Meeting, Day & Time, Location, Contact name, telephone number & email.. When will the change of information take place? Please be specific about the change you are requesting.

6. Lack of information or information that cannot be validated may contribute to a delay in your posting request. As well, questionable postings will be forwarded to the Intergroup Body for further review.

7. Any Alcoholics Anonymous Events wishing to be posted on our Website will be reviewed on an individual basis and if necessary, be forwarded to the Intergroup Body for further review.

8. These Guidelines are subject to change and additional information may be required as times change. (eg.the introduction of Hybrid Groups and the recent decision to register Online groups with the General Service Office in New York)

9. The Intergroup Website is considered a public medium and we have a responsibility to maintain the integrity of our Website. **Following the 12 Traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous is the solid foundation we base our decisions on.**
